Volunteers Needed

Join Keep Polk County Beautiful, Inc. for the Great American Cleanup during the months of March, April and May. This year, KPCB is holding a kick-off event on Saturday, March 13, 2010, from 8-noon. Activities will include beautification projects and litter removal from public parks, waterways and rights-of-way.

More than 2 million volunteers are expected to participate in this nationwide cleanup initiative led by Keep America Beautiful, Inc. The mission: to empower individuals to take greater responsibility for enhancing their community environment.

Neighborhood groups, churches, schools, civic clubs, businesses and individuals are encouraged to participate in the cleanup. The first 2,500 participants to pre-register by February 25th will receive a free t-shirt and complimentary admission into Bok Tower Gardens in Lake Wales.

In addition to these events, KPCB will hold a Tire Recycling event in Waverly at the corner of Waverly and Hodge Road.

In addition to tires, residents may bring rechargeable batteries that weigh one pound or less, used ink cartridges and mobile phones to be recycled.

Residents may discard of up to 10 tires at the event. Tires **MUST** be **STANDARD VEHICLE SIZE ONLY** and **OFF** the rims. Participants must show photo ID and proof of Polk County residency to take advantage of the free disposal. This limit will be strictly enforced.
