The Lake Wales Public Library will provide three sewing classes in October and November, *Basic Sewing for Children, Teens and Adults*.

With funding provided by the Lake Wales Library Association, the library has purchased six Singer sewing machines. The classes will be taught by Jodie Schmidt and Diana Davila.

These classes provide instruction in safely using a sewing machine, threading a machine and joining fabric. Also included are pinning, feeding, hemming, decorative stitching and other skills.

Basic Sewing for Teens will be held from 12:00 until 5:00 p.m., Saturday, October 16. Teens, ages 12 through 16 are invited to register. Five openings remain in this class. Register by calling 863-678-4004, ext. 221 or emailing, library@lakewalesfl.gov, no later than Thursday, October 14.

Basic Sewing for Adults is a two-part class, 2 until 4 p.m., November 8 & 9. Adult may register by calling 863-678-4004, ext. 221 or emailing, library@lakewalesfl.gov. Three spots remain in this class.

Basic Sewing for Children will be held during Thanksgiving Break, Monday through Wednesday, November 22 through 24, 1 until 3:30 p.m. Registrations are accepted for children ages 8 through 12. Participants will complete multiple projects during the class sessions. All supplies are provided.
