The Lake Wales Quilters Guild provides donations to Lake Wales Charter Schools, Lake Wales Care Center and the Polk County Sheriff's Department.

Members of the group are all skill levels, from beginners to experienced, enabling members to teach and learn from each other.

The Lake Wales Public Library's exhibit contains 28 quilts of all sizes.

The library's exhibit partners with the Lake Wales History Museum's exhibit *Creating Community through Quilts and Art*. The Lake Wales History Museum is located at 325 South Scenic Highway, and is open Wednesdays through Saturdays, 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.
