



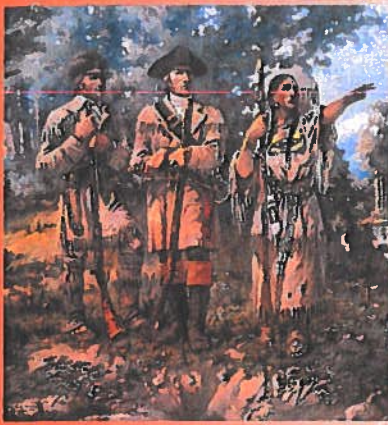

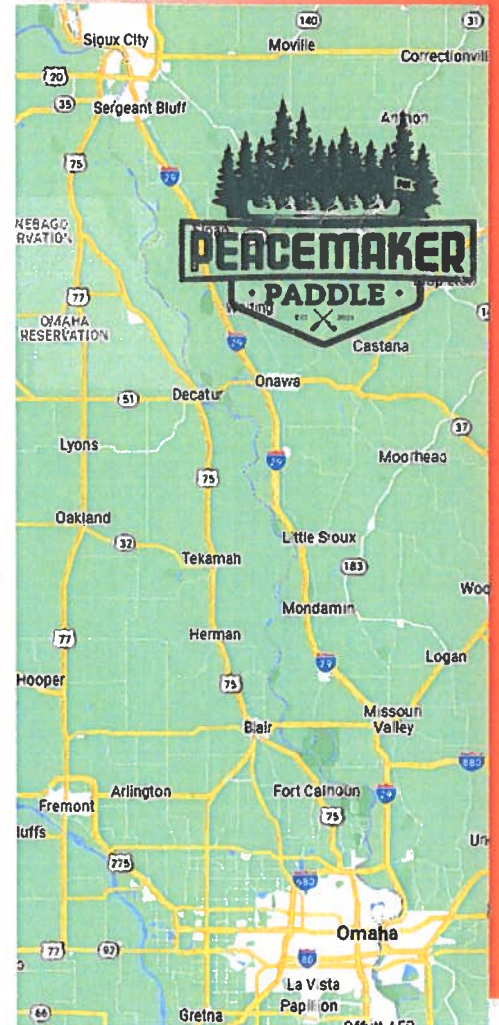
In 1803, an expedition known now as the Lewis and Clark expedition, began a journey up the longest river in North America in search of a passage to the Pacific Ocean. This expedition succeeded because they built a team that included Americans and French; men and women; Europeans and Native Americans; White, Brown and Black; and even a canine from Canada. It was, perhaps, our Nation's first PEACEMAKER PADDLE.

The 2022 PEACEMAKER PADDLE is the vision of an over 80, long-time paddler and peacemaker. The Missouri River was selected because of its historical significance and because it was once a route used by the Voyageurs for fur trading. Using giant Voyageur style canoes seemed only appropriate.

The PEACEMAKER PADDLERS are just ordinary people, not die hard paddlers, who want to make an extra-ordinary difference in the lives of people living with disabilities. While the nucleus comes from Florida, they are joined by caring people from many States.

The PEACEMAKER PADDLE will begin in Siouxland, travel 150 miles, and end in the Omaha/Council Bluffs area. Each night the team will exit the river to eat, sleep, and regain strength. Each paddler covers their own costs to the starting location and also is raising money to help build **StirringWaters**, a nonprofit specialty waterpark for people and families living with disabilities.

Sponsorship funds make the expedition possible by covering the on-location costs. No professional fundraisers are involved.
