Enrollment starts Oct. 25 for the Spring 2022 Semester at Polk State College

Wednesday, October 20, 2021 — Enrollment for the Spring 2022 Semester at Polk State College will start on Monday, October 25, 2021, with priority registration for students who have completed at least 50 percent of their program requirements. Open enrollment will begin on Monday, November 1, 2021, and classes will start on Wednesday, January 5, 2022.
